

Jean-Pierre Trotignon

Jean Pierre Trotignon is currently the executive Director of the network "n+i".

Previously Jean Pierre Trotignon was (1997-2000) Deputy Counselor for science at the Embassy of France (London) as well as (2010 -) Counselor of the Director of CampusFrance (national non-profit agency for promotion of higher education in France created by the French Ministry of Higher Education and Ministry of Foreign Affairs).

The main part of his carrier (until 1998) was being a Senior Professor at Arts et Métiers ParisTech as well as invited Professor (Ecole Centrale Paris, Ecole des Mines Paris, Universities of Chengdu (China), Sao Carlos (Brazil), Montreal (Canada).

During his academic carrier Jean Pierre Trotignon was Head of « Materials » Department, Arts et Métiers ParisTech, President of the Professors' committee Arts et Métiers ParisTech.

His work is known through 115 publications, communications in international books, journals and reviews, over 100 international conferences, 12 books as author and/or editor (VUP), 4 international patents, (INPI prize winner for innovation in 1986), and 22 scientific and technological videos.

At the same time, Jean Pierre Trotignon had also responsibilities as Scientific Counselor for Companies (Shell, Air Liquide, Micarec, etc.), Scientific Expert for the Ministry of Industry, President and/or member of International Scientific Committees (Eurofillers, DEPPOS, AMAC, MOFFIS, International Conference on Deformation and Fracture of Composites, Enercomp, ..).

Jean Pierre Trotignon graduated from Arts et Métiers ParisTech, (Master with honors). He got a Master of Sciences from Polytechnique, Université de Montréal, Canada), and then a PhD from University Pierre et Marie Curie, Paris VI, France.
