- 3. Nomination of the Peer Review Team
- 4. Site visit to the institution
- 5. Draft Peer Review Team Report
- 6. Comments on the Peer Review Team Report
- 7. Final Peer Review Team Report sent to the Accreditation Committee
- 8. Decision of the Accreditation Committee
