Janos Vecsenyi is currently Executive Director of EFER — European Forum for Entrepreneurship Research, the Netherlands.

During his carrier Prof. Vecsenyi has been teaching at Corvinus University since 1978 and at the Budapest University of Technology and Economics from 2011. His major courses include Entrepreneurship, Starting and Managing New Ventures, Launching Innovative New Ventures. He served as program director and professor of the first MBA program in Hungary at the International Manager Center, now CEU Business School. He was a visiting professor at University of Tulsa (USA), at INSEAD (France) and lectured among others at Harvard Business School, UCLA, UT Austin, Dallas, Tulane, University of Melbourne, London School of Economics, Czech Management Center (Prague), VNIISI, Moscow, Erasmus University (Rotterdam).

He extensively consulted major Hungarian firms. Up to 2010 he was working as Learning and Development Leader at GE Capital, Budapest Bank, for more than a decade.

Prof. Vecsenyi is a graduate of Budapest Technical University where he earned his degrees in mechanical and industrial engineering. He also holds a PhD from Budapest University of Economic Sciences, now Corvinus University. He has published three books on entrepreneurship: *Starting and Managing New Ventures* (2009, 2011, 2013); *Entrepreneurship. From an Idea to Restarting* (2002); *Entrepreneurial Organizations and Strategies* (1999), and developed an online start-up support tool www.startmybusiness123.com.
