Figure 1: Growth Rates in Turkey

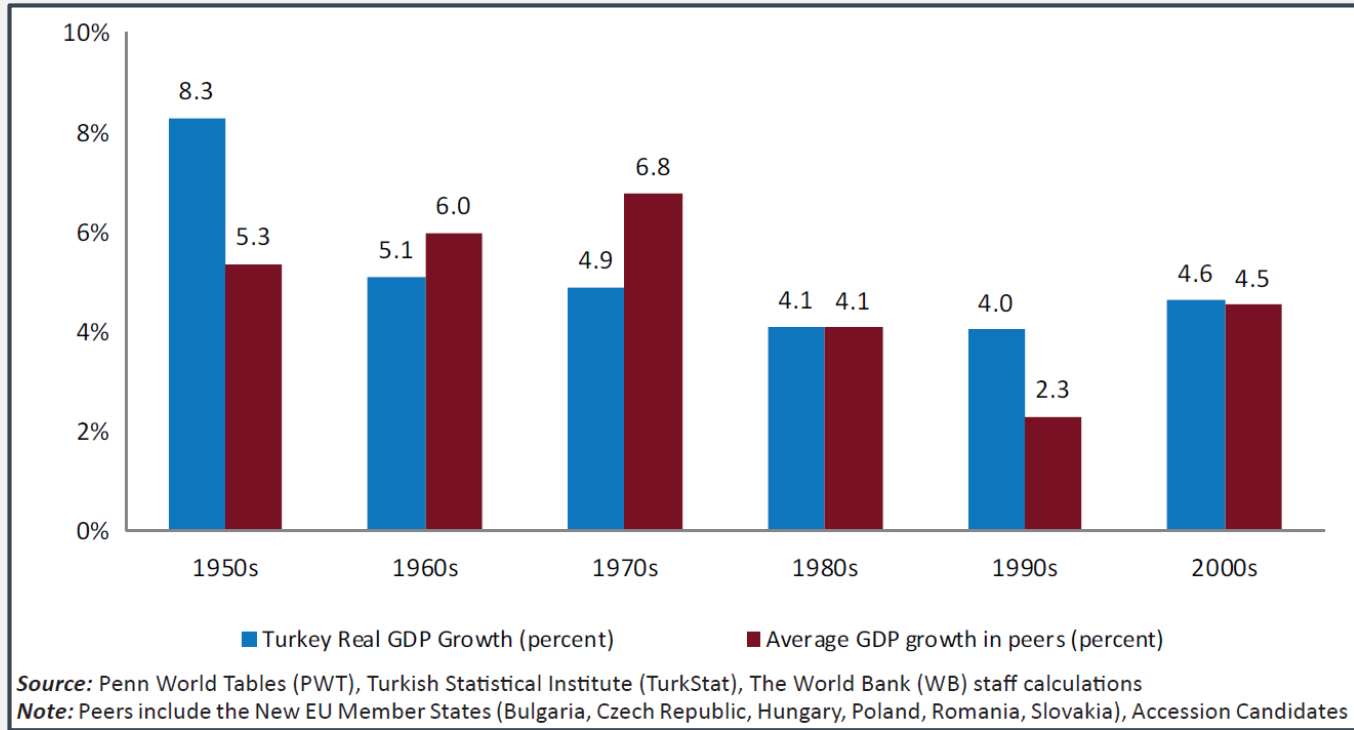


Figure 2: The middle class has doubled since 1993 in Turkey, although it remains smaller than expected

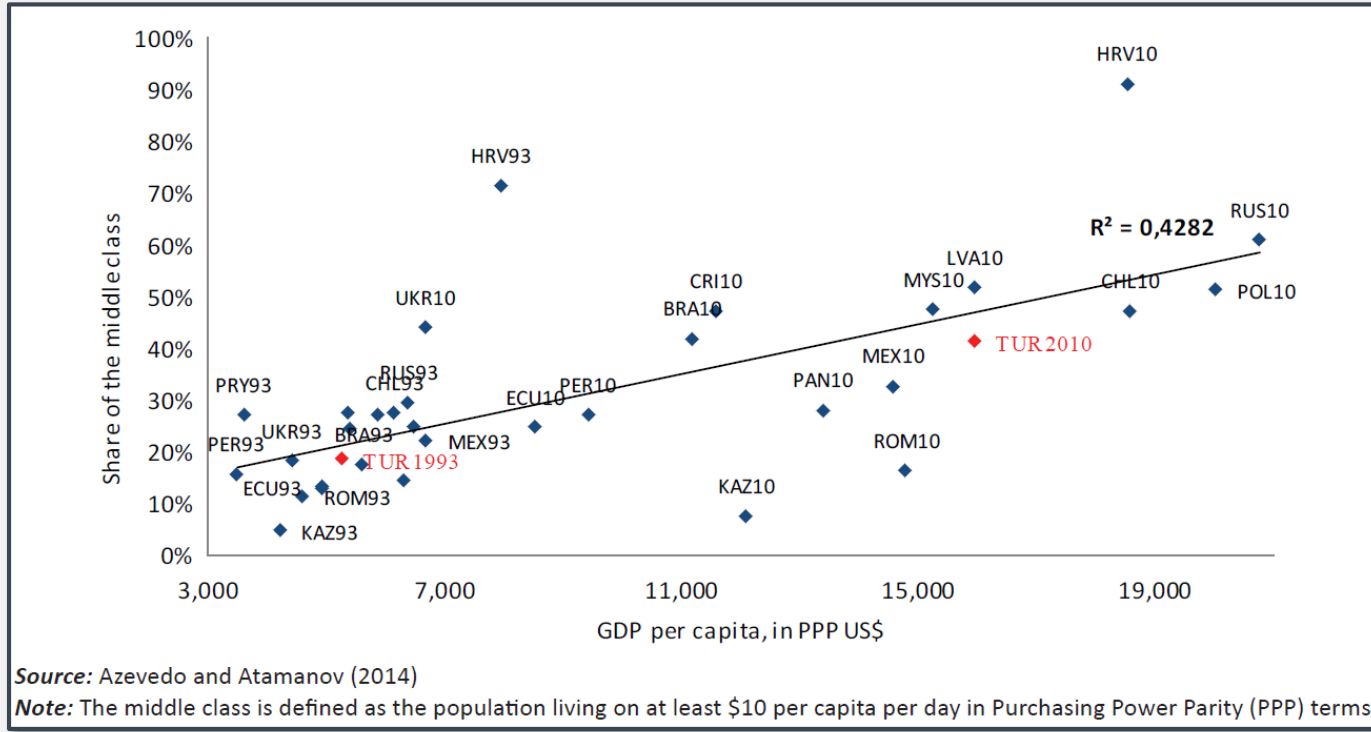


Figure 3: Dramatic structural change in Turkey

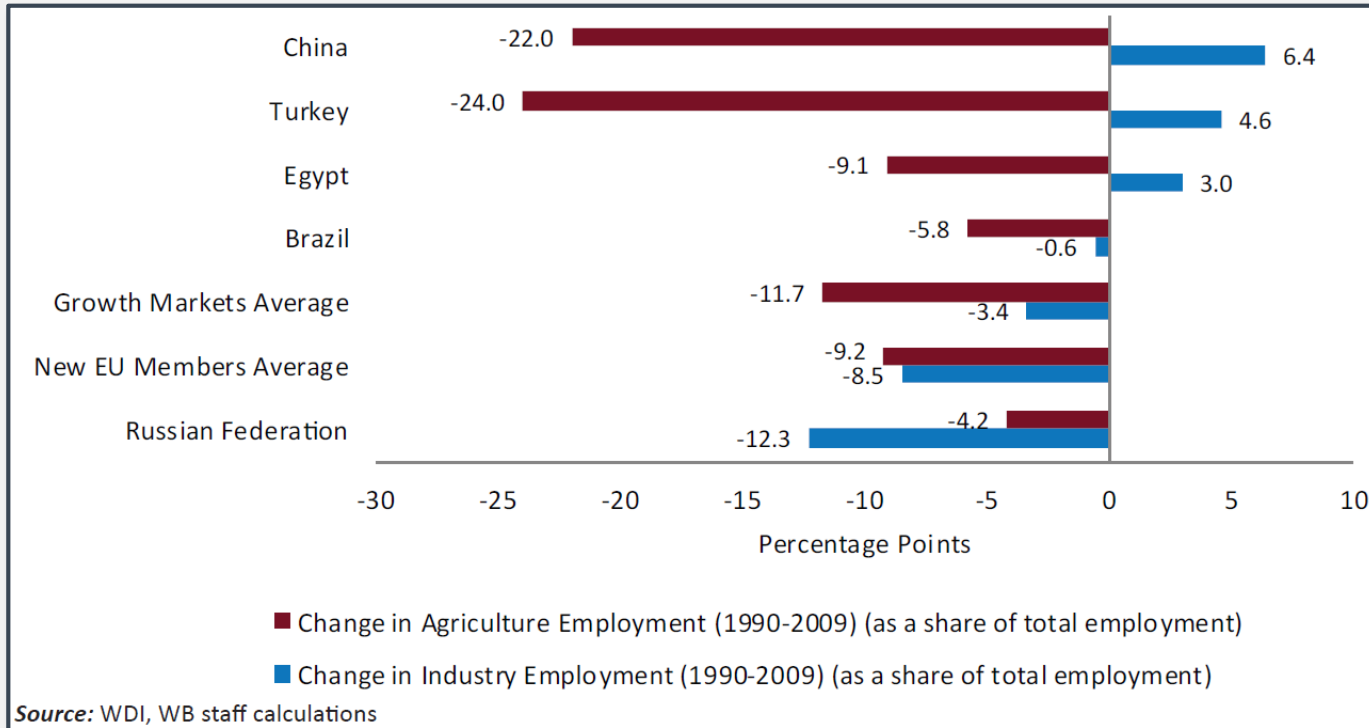


Figure 4: Median Age



Figure 5: Turkey's Demographic window of opportunity

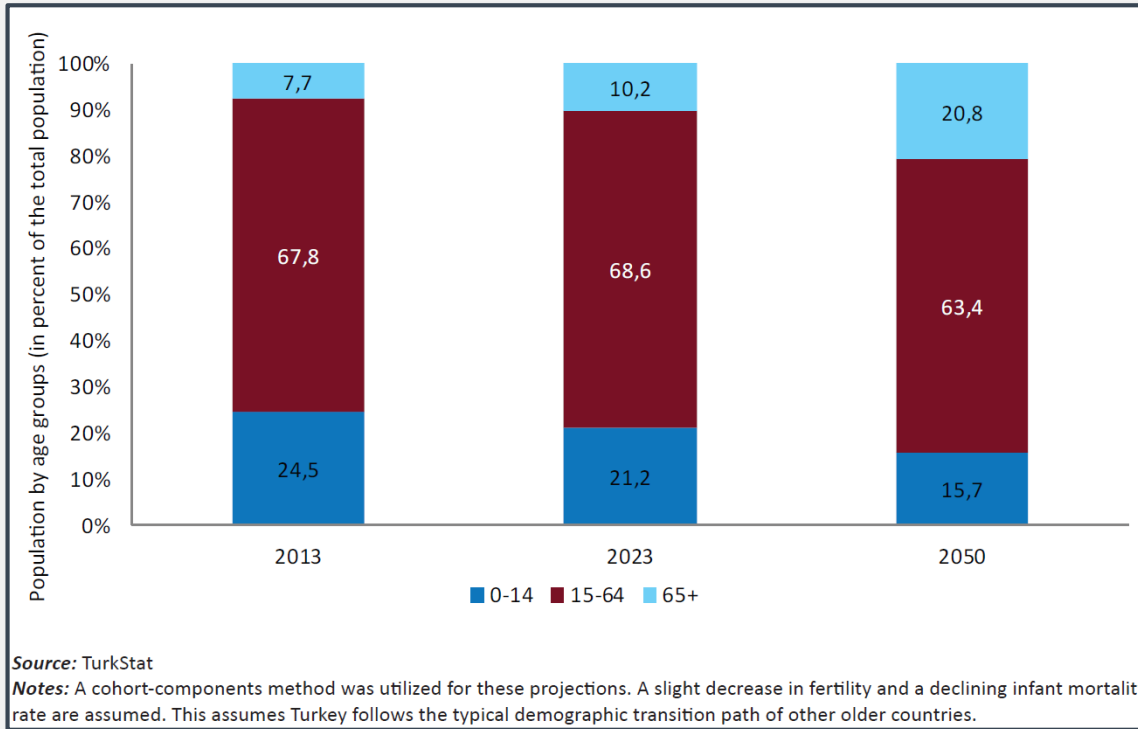


Figure 6: Educational attainment in Turkey

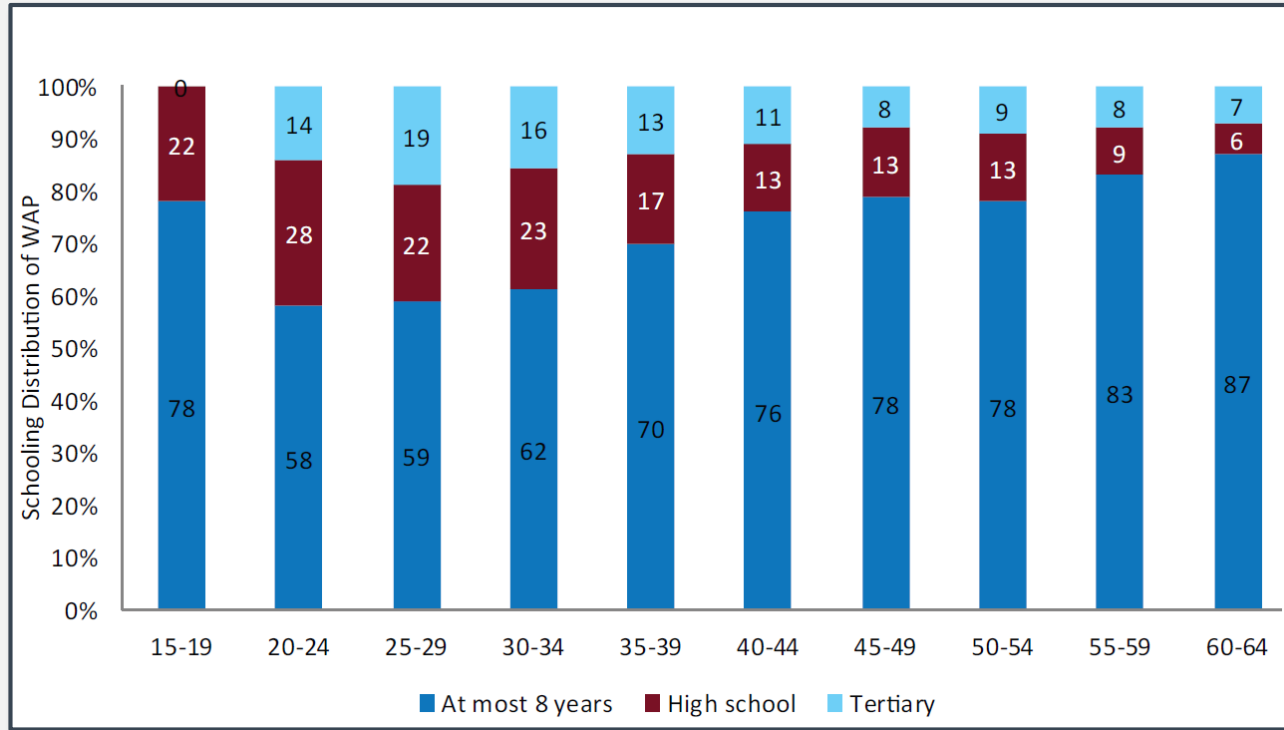


Figure 7: Number of higher education institutions

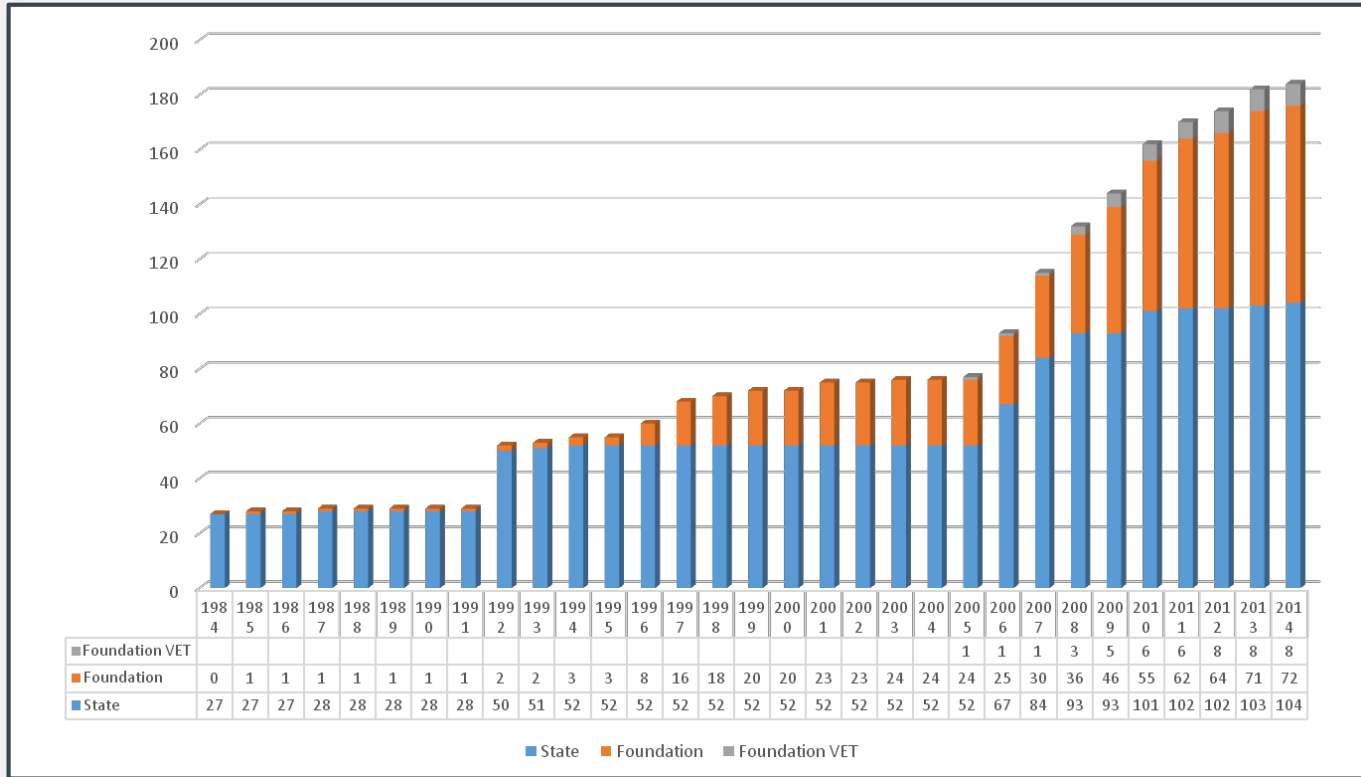


Figure 8: Structure of the higher education system

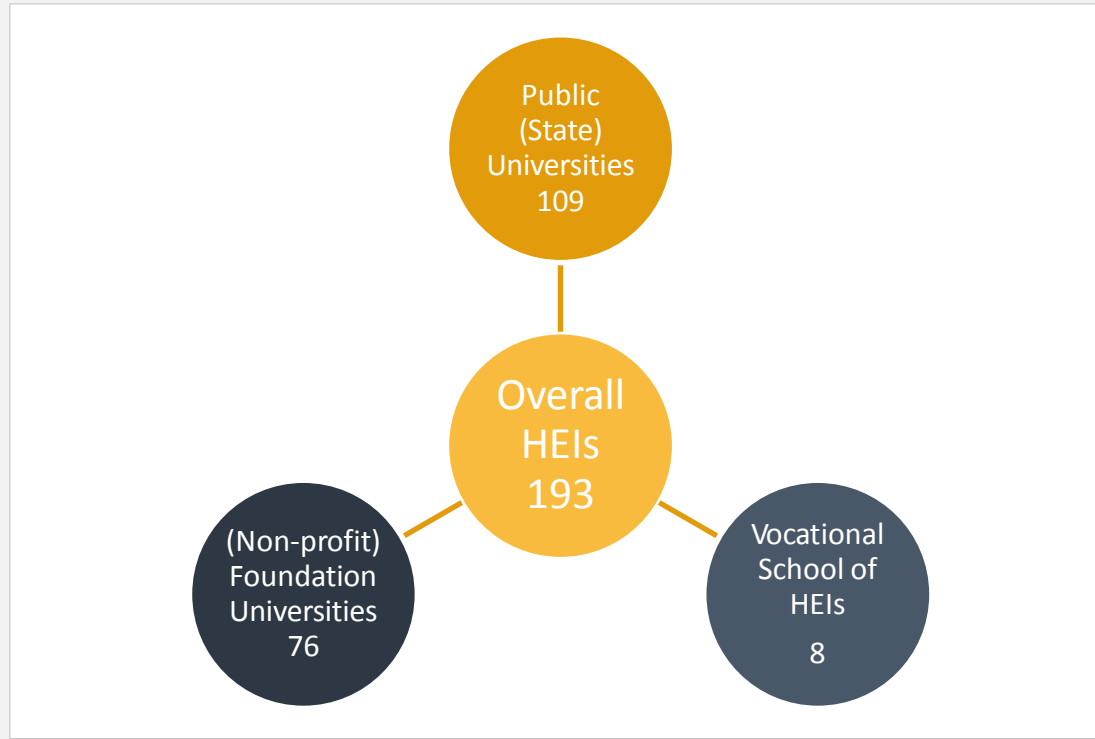
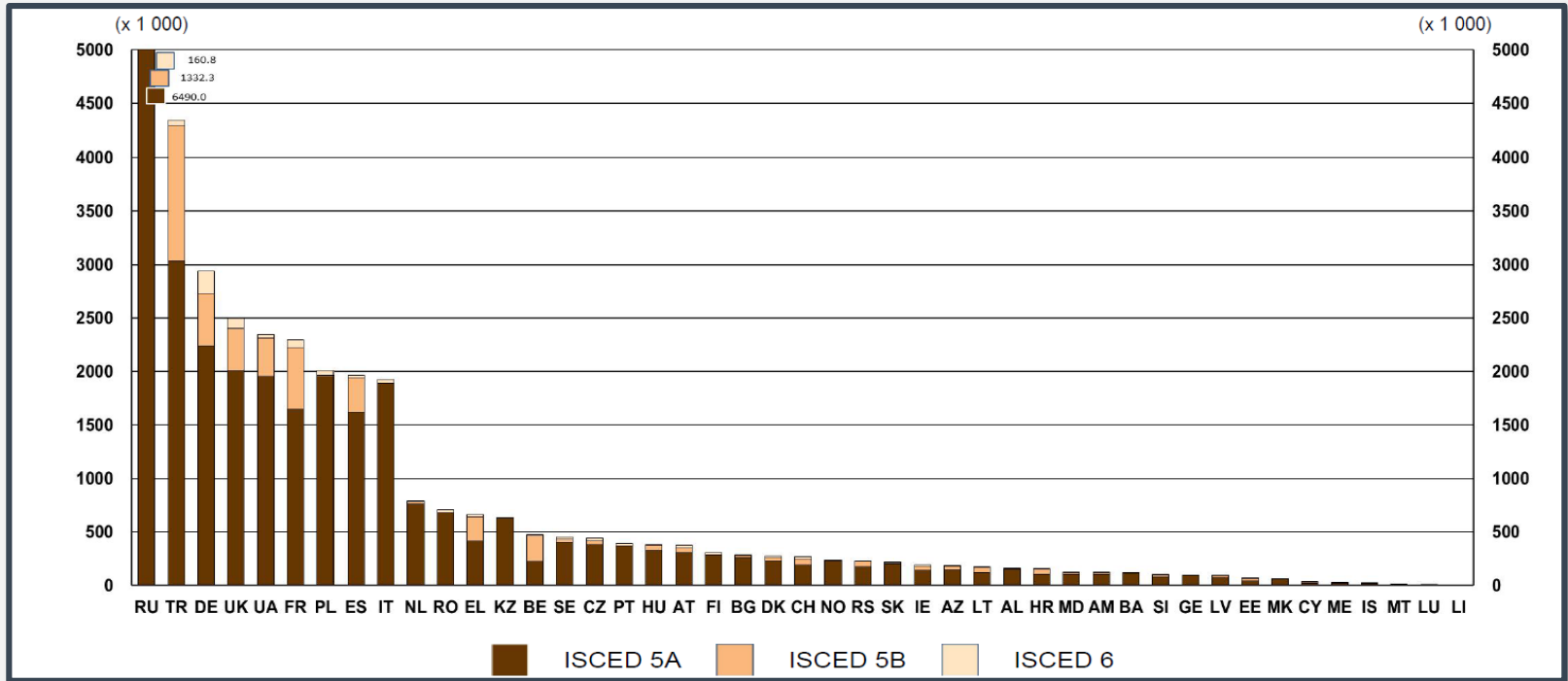
