



Recep Pekdemir

Dr. Pekdemir is a Professor of Accounting at the School of Business at Istanbul University. He received his Ph.D. degree in Accountancy from Istanbul University in 1990. He joined Istanbul University in 1983 as graduate assistant, and visited twice as visiting scholar to the University of Illinois at Urbana – Champaign 1988 to 1989, and also in 1998.

His research interests include international accounting and empirical financial accounting research. His editorial service recently includes the editorial advisory board of Accounting Education: an International Journal, Research in Accounting Regulation, and some others.

He was the Chairman of the 17th World Congress of Accountants in 2006, Chairman of the 10th World Congress of Accounting Educators in 2006, Chairman of the 10th World Congress of Accounting Educators and Researchers in 2006, and Chairman of the 33rd European Accounting Association Annual Congress in 2010. He served as Vice President at Large of the IAAER International Association for Accounting Education & Research during 2004-2010, Member of Management Committee of the EAA European Accounting Association during 2008-2010, and Member of Council of the AAA American Accounting Association during 2009-2010. He served as a Technical Advisor on both the Education Committee and the Developing Nations Committee, as a Member of the PAIB Professional Accountants in Business Committee of IFAC.

He served as the VP and Director Focusing on International of the AAA American Accounting Association (2011-2014), Member of Management Board of the EAA European Accounting Association (2013-2105).

He served the Director of Istanbul Graduate School of Business, Istanbul University for the term of 2011-2014. Since December 2014, he has been the Dean of the School of Business Istanbul University
