



## **Erhard Busek**

Dr. Erhard Busek is the Chairman of the Institute for the Danube Region and Central Europe, Coordinator of the Southeast European Cooperative Initiative (SECI), President of the Vienna Economic Forum (VEF).

He began his professional career in 1964 as legal adviser to the association of the parliamentarians of the Austrian People's Party. In 1976 Dr. Busek entered municipal politics. He was City Councilor and was elected Deputy-Mayor of Vienna in 1978, a position he held until 1987. He was appointed Minister for Science and Research in 1989 and had been a Minister for Education in 1994. He was elected Chairman of the Austrian People's Party in 1991 and served as Vice-Chancellor of Austria till 1995. In 2000 Dr. Busek was appointed as Special Representative of the Austrian Government on EU-Enlargement for two years. From 2002 to 2008 Dr. Busek served as Special Coordinator of the Stability Pact for South Eastern Europe.

He is Dr. hc. of the universities in Krakow, Bratislava, Brasov and Czernowitz, Liberec and Webster-St. Louis University Vienna, Visiting Professor at Duke University, NC, USA and at the University of Agriculture in Vienna.
