Barbara Sporn has been the Vice-Rector for International Affairs since 2002 and the Vice-Rector for Research, International Affairs and External Relations of WU (Vienna University of Economics and Business) since 2003.

She studied Business Administration at WU and obtained her doctorate in 1991 and her habilitation in 1999. She was Acting Assistant Professor (1996/97) at the School of Education at Stanford University and Visiting Research Fellow (1997) at the Stanford Institute for Higher Education Research. She has held visiting research scholar positions at the Stern School of Business at New York University, the School of Education at the University of Michigan, and at the Center for Studies in Higher Education of the University of California at Berkeley between 1992 and 1994. Barbara Sporn is Professor of University Management (on leave) at WU's Department of Strategy and Innovation.

From 2003 to 2006 she acted as Chair of the Partnership in Management (PIM) network. From 2007 to 2012, she was a member of the Board of Directors of UniManagement, Torino.

Today, she is a member of the CEMS Globalisation and Membership Committee and the CEMS Executive Board. She is a member of the Fulbright Commission Austria, as well as a Board Member of the Austrian Educational Exchange (OeAD).

She has published books and numerous journal articles on leadership and organization in higher education, university adaptation and change, international and comparative higher education, the globalization of higher education systems, and knowledge management and IT in non-profit organizations.
