## **KEYNOTE SPEAKERS**

Roger Martin – former dean of the Rotman School of Management at Toronto University in Canada, and author of 10 books and 15 articles for *Harvard Business Review*, is a renowned thought leader on the future of democratic capitalism. He was recently named the world's #1 management thinker by Thinkers50. His recent work and research focuses on integrative thinking and the role of the corporation in our society. Martin is a regular contributor and blogger for the *Washington Post, The Financial Times*, and *Businessweek*. **Johan Roos** – is a Swedish organizational theorist and the Chief Academic Officer and Professor of General Management and Strategy for Hult International Business School. He is responsible for all academic activities and accreditation across the various global campuses. He has written extensively on strategy, change and innovation. His work is highly integrated with accreditation, academic governance, and quality programming. Under Roos' direction, Hult International is the first school in America to achieve the "triple crown" in accreditation from AACSB, EQUIS and QAA. His presentation is entitled, "Making relevance more relevant."

**Danica Purg** – Founding President of CEEMAN and President of the IEDC-Bled School of Management, is a professor of leadership and effective management at the IEDC-Bled School of Management in Slovenia. For her visionary leadership, Purg has received numerous international awards, including "Educator of the Year" from the Academy of International Business, and Certificate of the Lifetime Achievement in the field of CSR, Sustainability, Ethics and Governance. She is a renowned thought-leader on changes needed in management education and accreditation for dynamic societies, and a champion of the arts in management. Purg has authored and co-authored several books and numerous articles on leadership.

Derek Abell – Founding President of ESMT European School of Management and Technology (Berlin) and a founding board member of CEEMAN, is the principal author of the *Manifesto:* Changing the Course of Management Development: Combining Excellence with Relevance. More than two years in the making and based on extensive research, the Manifesto lays out the rationale for a change in direction of management education to restore the balance between teaching and research and to combine that balance with a commitment to excellence and relevance. The 36-page document, which is signed by every board member of CEEMAN, will be introduced in an afternoon ceremony to more than 150 attending deans and directors from schools all over the world on 20 September 2018.
