



Alikhan Baimenov

Alikhan Baimenov is Chairman of the Steering Committee of the Regional Hub of Civil Service.

In 1981 he graduated from the Karaganda Polytechnic Institute and in 1988 finished post-graduate studies at the Moscow Motor-Road Institute. He is a candidate of technical sciences.

He was the leader of Ulytau movement (from 1989), Chairman of the Zhezkazgan branch of Nevada-Semei public-political movement (1989-1994), head of The People's Unity of Kazakhstan association on the oblast level (1993-1994).

Baimenov served as the Deputy Minister of Labor (1995-1996), Deputy Head of the Administration Office of the President of the Republic of Kazakhstan – the Chief of the Organization-Controlling Department in the Administration Office of the President of the Republic of Kazakhstan (1996-1997), and Head of the Administration Office of the President of the Republic of Kazakhstan (1998-1999).

He was a co-founder and the co-Chairman of AK ZHOL democratic party of Kazakhstan (2002-2005) and Chairman of political executive Committee of the party (2003-2005). He headed the AK ZHOL party list during the elections to the Majilis (lower Chamber of Parliament) of the Republic of Kazakhstan in 2004. Refused from the deputy's mandate in solidarity with constituents whose votes were not counted in the official election results. In March 2005 he became the Chairman of AK ZHOL democratic party of Kazakhstan.

Besides that, he is the President of Zerde public foundation, Head of Temir Kazy intellectual club, and the President of Togyz Kumalak national federation.

He is the author of a monograph *Public Service. International Experience. Kazakhstani Model* (2000) and a series of publications on issues of social protection, public management and public service, management, as well as political and party building.
