Pavlo Sheremeta is Director, School of Public Management, Ukrainian Catholic University in Lviv, Ukraine.

He earned his undergraduate degree in economics at the Lviv University and an MBA degree at Emory University in Atlanta, USA. He completed a number of management development programs at the Harvard Business School, the INSEAD Blue Ocean Strategy Institute, and the China Europe International Business School. In 1999, Sheremeta became the Founding Dean of Kyiv Mohyla Business School. From 2004–2008, he was the Board member of the Central and East European Management Development Association CEEMAN. During 2008 to 2011, he was the President and Institute Senior Fellow of the Malaysia Blue Ocean Strategy Institute, which advised the Malaysian government on economic reforms. From November 2012 until February 2014 he was the President of the Kyiv School of Economics. On February 27, 2014 Sheremeta became the Minister of Economic Development and Trade of Ukraine and stayed on as an Minister till September 2.
