Shen Kunrong, who has Ph.D in Economics, is a postdoctoral researcher of the Chinese Academy of Social Sciences and a senior researcher of Economics Department of Stanford University. His research areas span across Microeconomics, Transition Economics, Economics Growth, Financial Economics, Capital Market, and Corporate Development Strategy.

Shen Kunrong is the Dean of School of Business, Changjiang Scholar, Professor, Ph.D Supervisor, a member of teaching instruction of Steering Committee of Ministry of Education, part-time Professor of the Johns Hopkins University-Nanjing University Center for Chinese and American Studies, and Vice Chairman of the Chinese Industrial Economic Association.

He is one of the first batch selected by Supporting Plan for New Century Excellent Talents, one of the candidates for the One Hundred plus One Thousand plus Ten Thousand Talents Project of the New Century. He has won the National Famous Teacher Award of Higher Education and the top award of Chinese economics-Sun Yefang Economic Science Award. Meanwhile, he is the winner of “Zhang Peigang” Development Economics Outstanding Achievement Award, and the winner of first term “Liu Shibai” Economics Award.

Prof. Shen works concurrently as director of the China Price Association, a panelist of “the 12th Five-Year Plan” and “the 13th Five Year Plan” of Jiangsu Provincial Government, and president of the Jiangsu Transportation and Economic Research Association, as well as a member of Advisory Committee for Nanjing municipal people's government, consultant of Suzhou municipal people's government.
