



Wei Huang

As a Distinguished Expert of “1,000 Talents Plan” and Distinguished Professor of Changjiang Scholars awarded by the Ministry of Education, Huang Wei is a professor, Doctoral Supervisor and the Dean of the School of Management, Xi’an Jiaotong University. He was also a Fellow of Harvard University and a Tenured Professor of Management Information Service of Ohio University. He has rich teaching and research experiences in research universities of America, Australia, Hong Kong, Singapore and China for more than two decades.

Professor Huang Wei has conducted researches in areas such as Managerial Communication (CMC), Group Support Systems (GSS), big data management and data quality, e-government affairs/e-commerce, IT and service outsourcing and IT/IS management which are based on the new generation of information technology. His research outcomes include: more than 10 books published in America and Germany (including book chapters); 120 paper-reviewed publications on MIS Quarterly (MISQ) Journal of MIS (JMIS), IEEE Transactions, Communications of ACM (CACM), ACM Transactions and European Journal of Information Systems (EJIS), other international journals and Paper Collections of international conferences. There are more than 1700 citations of his publications, with more than 100 citations from the 10 top international journals, such as Management Science (MS), Operations Research (OR), MIS Quarterly (MISQ), Information Systems Research (ISR) and Journal of MIS (JMIS). His H factor is 22.
