Steef van de Velde (1960) has been the Dean of the Rotterdam School of Management, Erasmus University since 2011, and a professor of Operations Management & Technology since 1999.

He holds an MSc in Econometrics (Erasmus University, 1985) and a PhD in Mathematics and Computer Science (Eindhoven University of Technology, 1991). Before joining the Rotterdam School of Management in 1997, he worked at the School of Mechanical Engineering of the University of Twente (Enschede, The Netherlands, 1993-1997), the University of Toronto (1992-1993), the School of Industrial Engineering of the University of Twente (1990-1992) and the Center for Mathematics and Computer Science (Amsterdam 1985-1990).

He is a member of AMBA's Board of Trustees (2018 -), serves on the AMBA's Initial Accreditation Advisory Board (2017-) and is a member of AACSB's Initial Accreditation Committee (2013-2016; 2018 -). He is a frequent Peer Review Team Member for AMBA and AACSB accreditations and occasionally for EQUIS accreditations. In addition, he is on the supervisory board of various limited companies and on the advisory boards of several international business schools. He is a visiting professor at the American University in Cairo and the Tanri Abeng University in Jakarta.

He has published in leading operations research and operations management journals, and in the past he was on the editorial boards of Operations Research, IIE Transactions and Operations Research Letters. He is one of the founding editors of Journal of Scheduling. He has been extensively involved in executive education for companies from many sectors in various countries around the world.
