Currently, Zh.A. Kulekeyev serves as an Advisor to the Chairman of the Board of JSC NC KazMunayGas. J.A. Kulekeyev possesses a wealth of experience in leadership within national companies, the public sector, and higher education. In the sphere of national companies, his career journey encompasses key positions at renowned organizations:

- JSC NC KazMunayGas: As Advisor to the General Director of KMG Engineering LLP (2014-2021), Advisor to the General Director of KING JSC (2010-2014), and his role as First Vice President (2006-2007).
- JSC NC 'Kazakhstan temir zholy': He notably served as President (2007-2008).
