
We are dedicated to advancing the case method worldwide, sharing knowledge, wisdom and experience to inspire and transform business education across the globe

Submitting cases



- downloadable registration pack includes:
 - information to include on the front page of the case and teaching note
 - key elements required in the teaching note
 - how to obtain the necessary release documents
- no referee process, comprehensive testing before submission
- teaching note and learning objectives required
- permission required for field based cases
- royalties on case sales if at member organisation



Copyright and third parties



- copyright is always retained by the author or institution
- we distribute through our own website but we also work with a few distribution partners including:
 - McGraw-Hill
 - Study.Net
 - University Readers
- we work hard to protect the intellectual property of our authors and publishers




Outstanding Case Writer: Hot Topic




Outstanding Case Teacher
