Sergey Mordovin is Rector of International Management Institute of St. Petersburg (IMISP), Russia and professor of HRM. He is also a visiting professor at a number of universities and business schools in Russia and abroad (Italy, Finland, Latvia, and Kazakhstan).

He graduated from the Baltic Technical University, Russia in 1974, specializing in engineering and production and holds a PhD degree in Economics. Prof. Mordovin has also studied abroad at Ashridge Management College and Henley Management College, UK; and BOCCONI University, Italy.



Prof. Mordovin has occupied managerial positions in Defense Industries in St Petersburg. From 1974-1987, and has been Vice-Rector of St Petersburg State University for two years before joining IMISP in 1989.

He published six books and more than 100 articles on international activities, management and management training issues in Europe and Russia and is a member of the Editing Committee of the *Business Education Journal*, Russia.

Prof. Mordovin is CEEMAN Board Member and member of the CEEMAN International Quality Accreditation Committee, as well as Board Member of RABE (Russian Association of Business Education).
